May I start by saying thank you to exhibitors for turning out, even though you had to make do with a substitute judge. My main concerns were a few short necks & lack of muscletone, neither of which are good for allowing true Border Collie movement. The majority of dogs were well presented & temperaments were very good. I was delighted to see our BOB take G2.
